This teaching field also requires passage of the Praxis II test with a score of 166 on the PLT P - 3 Early Childhood (0521), or 168 on the PLT 5 – 9 (0523), or 165 on the PLT 7 - 12 (0524) and a score of 157 on the Art Content Knowledge (0133) tests in order to be eligible to student teach.
